General Information

The Malcolm Rector Technical High School (MRTHS) is located at the Nacogdoches Independent School District Technical Training Center. We are at 6003 North Street, Nacogdoches, Texas. MRTHS provides education for students who are at-risk of not graduating at the end of their senior year or at-risk of dropping out of high school. A student must meet at least one of the identified criteria to be considered for admission into the program. Students are required to attend all required hours per day according to the MRTHS schedule. Students are accepted into MRTHS on a priority basis for graduation. Students will receive a Malcolm Rector Technical High School diploma at graduation, upon completion of all local and state graduation requirements.

Bus transportation is provided by the district or the student may drive or be dropped off at the campus. Students must arrive ON TIME. Student drivers must provide proof of auto insurance and have a valid driver's license.

MRTHS students **will not be allowed in class unless they are in dress code and the student will be placed in refocus.**

- _____ Student agrees to turn in cell phone/watch upon entering the classroom.
- _____ Students are required to follow Malcolm Rector Technical High School dress code handbook, arrive on time, and stay the duration of their individual scheduled school day.
- _____ In case of absences, parent/guardian is to call the school informing of absence AND send note stating the reason for absence. If absent for more than 3 consecutive days, student must provide a physician's note.
- _____ If a student is tardy, he/she is required to attend lunch detention.
- _____ Students will use the Assignment Calendar to track what course work has to be completed for each day and week. This assures meeting minimum requirement.
- _____ Students may work ahead in course progress which will enable them to complete the course(s) before end of term. Credit will be awarded upon completion and passing of course(s).
- _____ Students should show a proficiency of 70% or above on each lesson, quiz, and lab assessment to proceed to the next lesson. Quizzes and Test must be submitted on your own the first time in order to get help. **With notes**, students have 2 attempts to reach 70% proficiency or above. If the student does not meet this requirement, he/she will be redirected back to the lesson to review before attempting the test/quiz again.
- _____ Students must maintain adequate academic progress, as monitored daily, by being on pace to complete a minimum of 5 credits per semester.
Students not meeting the requirement of 10% progress a day per subject, will be placed on academic probation and a parent conference is mandatory.
- _____ Students will abide by the Rules and Procedures set forth in the MRTHS Handbook and the NISD Student Code of Conduct.
- _____ I understand that enrollment in MRTHS diploma program is bound by this contract.
- _____ Students must have a 70% or above for each course to receive credit for the course.
- _____ Students may not have electronic devices during the school day. This includes, but is not limited to, radios, tape/CD/DVD players, iPods/MP3 players, cameras, Cellphones, electronic games and watches without administrative consent.
- _____ 7:30 arrival time with class starting at 8:00 and dismissal at 3:20. Leaving early will count as a tardy.
